

To win in November it's critical that voters can and do vote. By CAN vote, we mean that they're registered and understand how to vote in the face of voter suppression laws - by mail, where to sign the ballot, ID needed, etc. And, voters need to understand the importance of the mid-term elections. Happily, there are grassroots groups in our battleground states that are doing this educational work year-round to prepare specific constituencies for the midterms.

Force Multiplier has carefully vetted each one of them. We met with their leaders, reviewed 2020 + 2021 outcomes + 2022 goal + work plans. All have excellent leadership + strong financial management + budgets that enable them to fulfill their work plan + all need financial support. We have strong relationships with leaders of all these groups.

These organizations are non-partisan and therefore can access voters that partisan groups cannot - in high schools, detention centers, community colleges, etc. Donations to them are tax-deductible + they can accept funds from RMDs (Required Minimum Distributions), family foundations + Donor Advised Funds. Autocracy Revealed:

Lessons from Jan 6 Committee so far!

Autocracy: a form of government in which a country is ruled by a person or group with total power. The Britannica Dictionary

- Our most basic democratic values of free + fair elections + a peaceful transition of power were under siege + still are.
- The former President willfully planned, orchestrated + instigated an insurrection in the interest of maintaining power. This unprecedented coup was an attack on our constitution + our democratic values, an effort to illegally seize power following a lawful election.
- Despite extraordinary evidence to the contrary + despite what he was told by his most senior advisors (including the Attorney General) + political allies, the former President knowingly spread + continues to spread the totally unsubstantiated message of "stop the steal" + falsehoods about his overwhelming victory.
- Commission Chairman Rep. Bennie Thompson, (D-MS) best encapsulated what we know in his

 The evidence presented depicts a President as the ultimate grifter - using the Big Lie as a premise for fundraising that arguably has defrauded his supporters while enriching the Trump enterprise.

What can we do in the face of the Big Lie? How do we counter efforts to illegitimately seize power?

Nearly six in ten Republicans believe Trump bears no responsibility for January 6th. A similar number believe that the election was stolen from him. If we are to hold Trump accountable + if the corrosive impact of Trump's autocratic nature is to be checked, we need to trust the democratic process through the electoral system—beginning with the midterm elections.

Without a Democratic majority in the House, these hearings never would have happened. Without these hearings, the full truth would never have come out.

Simply put, we need to hold + expand our majorities in Congress. This is our only goal at Force Multiplier.

GREG LANDSMAN Ohio 01

Landsman has degrees in Economics/Political Science from Ohio University + Theology from Harvard Divinity School. He worked on Sen. Bill Bradley's Presidential Campaign in 2000 + Nancy Pelosi's campaign the same year. He attended Harvard Divinity School after 9/11 + was Director of the Ohio Governor's Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiatives from 2007 to 2010. In this role, Landsman was Chair of the Governor's Anti-Poverty Task Force. He then served as Executive Director of STRIVE Partnership Knowledge Foundation, an education + advocacy group.

Landsman was first elected to the Cincinnati City Council in 2017 + again in 2021. On Council, he has enacted eviction prevention reform + led creation of the Children + Families Cabinet. In 2021, he led the passage of a Balanced Development Plan which assesses the effects of new development. He pushed for funding for Cincinnati's "Level-Up: Launch your Career" program, providing young people with access to well-paying jobs.

HILLARY SCHOLTEN MI 03

Scholten graduated from Gordon College and the University of Maryland's School of Law. She was a judicial law clerk + attorney adviser for the U.S. Department of Justice Board of Immigration Appeals + a staff attorney for the Michigan Immigrant Rights Center, where she worked on the growing immigration crisis. She volunteered for Times Up Legal Defense Fund, providing legal services to women facing sexual harassment in the workplace. Since 2021 Scholten has been Senior Counsel at Miller Johnson in Grand Rapids.

Scholten is running for Congress because: "we need a leader who is committed to putting forth common-sense solutions to the pressing problems facing West Michigan... who will roll up her sleeves to help working families + who will do what's right, not what's easy."

MAKING THE CASE:

Why support grassroots efforts in other states?

Many people, including me, have wondered why someone in Massachusetts should support grassroots organizing in other states. Put simply, the answer is that EVERY Congressional and Senatorial race in EVERY state matters. And we have seen that some races, especially in "battleground" states, can be decided by fewer than 1,000 votes.

Some wonder if we are interfering with local politics by supporting grassroots organizing in other states. The answer is no. We are helping people in Nevada talk to people in Nevada about

filibuster.

A few years ago, I was canvassing in New Hampshire when a resident asked why I would come from Massachusetts to knock on doors there. In hindsight it may have been more effective to donate to a reputable NH-led organization. But I believe that both canvassing and donating are important ways to affect the bigger national picture. Force Multiplier has done volumes of research on impressive organizations throughout the country that are worthy of our support. As an American, I plan to do whatever I can to help.

5 Positive TALKING POINTS

1. It's not the time to give up

Elections are still 5 months away. At this point in the last 3 election cycles, the outcome was not clear. Anything can happen— the supreme court rulings + the Jan 6th hearings + the economy are all in play + will influence how people vote.

2. We need to re-ignite the surge

In the past two elections Democrats added 25 million new voters who rose up to repudiate Trumpism. If we ignite those blue surge voters we have a huge advantage for the midterms. Our Voter Empowerment groups are doing that work every day.

3. Another element of hope

Many Republican nominees are just too extreme for the general elections. MAGA candidates + extremists of all flavors do not have broad appeal.

4. There is good news

Despite low Presidential approval ratings, new voter suppression laws + a tough economy, Democrats did well in 2021 municipal elections in places like GA + NH.

5. This is a time like no other

Generic indicators such as Presidential approval ratings + historical trends can not be accurate ways of predicting outcomes when there is no normal. We're in new territory + we need to seize the moment!


