# "The resurrection of democracy + freedom in Wisconsin has begun"

On April 4th over 1.8M Wisconsin voters turned out to give Judge Janet Protasiewicz an 11 point victory, flipping the Wisconsin Supreme Court to a progressive majority. This new majority will be able to address gerrymandered election districts + voting rights + an outdated 1849 abortion ban + workers' rights + more.

The victory was the product of an extraordinary coalition led by the Wisconsin Democratic Party, the Protasiewicz campaign + the America Votes-Wisconsin Coalition + supported by grassroots donors around the country, including Force Multiplier.

Our collective support for this coalition enabled them to knock on more than 535,000 strategically chosen doors + to add more layers of voter contact including phone calls, mail, texts, relational outreach + more.

#### The Wisconsin Democratic Party released the following statement:

"The resurrection of democracy + freedom in Wisconsin has begun...
tonight's victory is the result of years of unglamorous work by volunteers, activists, union
members, + organizers across our state who never lost the faith that a better future was possible
—even when hope seemed all but lost. Tonight is a testament to the power of never giving up. And
it's a testament to the whirlwind that the foes of democracy—in Wisconsin + in America—can
expect to reap.

While we may have won tonight, we know that the threat posed to our freedoms + our democracy by MAGA extremism continues. And that's why we will never stop organizing. We will use this moment as a springboard into the long work ahead—to build a multiracial democracy in which all of us, no matter our gender or gender identity, our generation or the geography in which we live, has a voice, has dignity + has the power that is supposed to be the birthright of all American citizens."

This victory is tremendously important for Wisconsin + the nation + sets a new tone for the 2024 cycle.

If we start early, work together, + talk to voters about issues they care about, we can win again.

"Candidates, PACs + party organs have become increasingly reliant on free mediums (such as email or social media advertising) + low-cost mediums (such as phone calls + text messages) to get their message across to voters + potential donors. As a result, voters are inundated with spam messages they cannot opt-out of or avoid." *Michigan Election Blog* 

Commercial e-mail spam is federally regulated by the CAN-SPAM Act of 2003, which lists five practices that commercial senders must abide by to give email recipients the ability to limit additional contact from the sender. However, those protections do not apply to political messages, which are protected by the First Amendment. Senders of political emails are not required to provide you with an opt-out option, or a clear subject heading, for example.

This problem is worsened by groups that flood your inbox with appeals that do not respect your time or political intelligence.

These practices alienate + discourage potential donors from engaging in this important act of citizenship.

#### FM cannot stop these trends BUT we can model a different way.

- We email only when we have received your permission to do so.
- · We never share, swap or sell our lists.
- By donating through FM, you will never be added to another email list without your permission.
- FM Act Blue pages always ask your permission before sharing your email address with a candidate or group you support. Act Blue will respect your choice.
- You may unsubscribe at any time.
- We send an average of 2-3 emails a week.
- Our emails provide information on why we think a candidate or group deserves your support.
   We're committed to fundraising practices that respect our donors + that will sustain the work of our candidates + groups over the long haul. We're committed to the idea that "our tactics must match our values."

#### Meet FM's Two New Senate Slate Candidates

In 2024, Democrats must defend 23 Senate seats to simply maintain their slim majority. Our current Senate slate includes incumbents Jon Tester + Jacky Rosen + Sherrod Brown + Tammy Baldwin. Full profiles of each can be found here.



Jacky Rosen in Nevada was elected to the US House in 2016 + to the Senate in 2018. Rosen was the only Democrat to defeat an incumbent Republican senator.

In 2021, Senator Rosen helped write + pass the historic Bipartisan Infrastructure law which, among other advances, supports well-paying jobs + modernizes airports + repairs roads + bridges + makes the internet faster + more widely available + affordable.

Rosen will face a strong challenge from a yet-to-be named Republican in this battleground state.

**Jon Tester in Montana** has served in the US Senate from Montana since 2007. He is a third generation Montana farmer + a former school music teacher.

Tester brings a strong voice to Veterans Affairs, currently chairing the VA Committee. He is an advocate for family farmers + small businesses + ranchers + public lands + Tribal Nations + is a leading champion of government transparency + accountability.

In '18, Tester was the only Democratic senator from a Republican-leaning state to win reelection, even after voting against Trump's Supreme Court picks. Republican state lawmakers in Montana are working hard to unseat Tester by altering the Senate primary to allow the top two vote getters to win slots on the 2024 ballot – regardless of party. Clearly, early support for Tester is vital to his re-election.
